## **Guidelines for Abstract Presentation**

We invite individuals to submit abstracts on "neuro-rehabilitation" for platform presentations.

Names and contact details, email, phone numbers. Please indicate the name of the presenters clearly.

Submission: All abstracts must be submitted at <a href="mailto:ihif.conference@gmail.com">ihif.conference@gmail.com</a> by 15<sup>th</sup> Feb.2014 and should include the following

- Names and contact details, email, phone numbers.
- Use English language only.
- Limit your title to 100 letters and abstracts to 250 words.
- Use times new roman, 14 font for title, 12 font for text and 12 font bold for subtitle with double spacing.
- Prepare structured abstract with background/introduction & objectives, methods, results, conclusions and key words.
- Define each abbreviation the first time it is used in the text by placing in parentheses.
- Do not include references in the abstract.
- Type authors names without degree or title, underline the presenter name,
- Do not mention author's name anywhere in the text.
- Kindly mention your Registration number of the conference as it is must & submit your abstract.

A platform presentation is an 8 minutes oral presentation of a paper followed by 2 minutes of question time, moderated by a chair.

## Guidelines for poster presentation..THEME-NEUROREHABILITATION

- Posters are reports summarizing information using brief written statements and graphic materials, such as
  graphs, charts, figures and photographs, mounted on a poster board. Scientific committee will decide about
  the best poster.
- Size: width 3 feet and height 4 feet.
- Title must be displayed clearly at the top of the poster and should include the names of the author and the institution.
- Designated times for poster presentations will be incorporated into the conference.

•	Poster presenters should be available to discuss their posters with the conference participants during these periods and during the coffee breaks.
