

5th Multidisciplinary International Conference on Neuro-Rehabilitation: Developing Skills
Theme : Neuro Rehabilitation Subsequent to Head & Spine Injury (27th & 29th November 2015)

The “Indian Head Injury Foundation” (IHIF) conducted a very successful Multidisciplinary International Neuro Rehab Conference “Developing Skills” held on 27th and 28th November 2015 at IIC New Delhi. The Conference was supported by Indraprastha Apollo Hospitals and World Federation for Neuro Rehabilitation (WFNR). The theme for the conference was ‘Neuro-Rehab subsequent to Head or Spinal cord Injury’. There was a large participation from across the world and from India and around 160 delegates and 40 faculties participated in the event.
